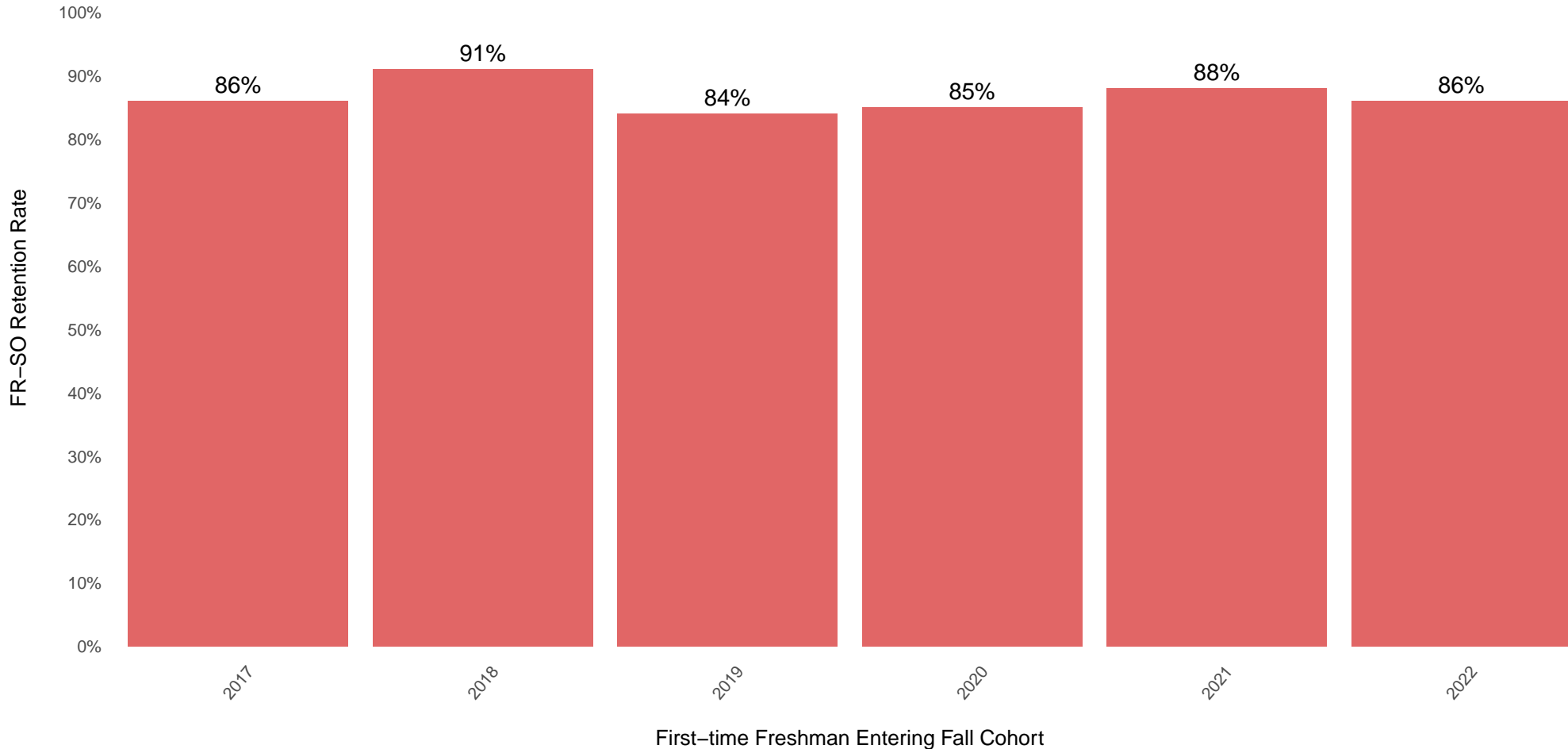


Wabash College Freshman to Sophomore Retention Rates

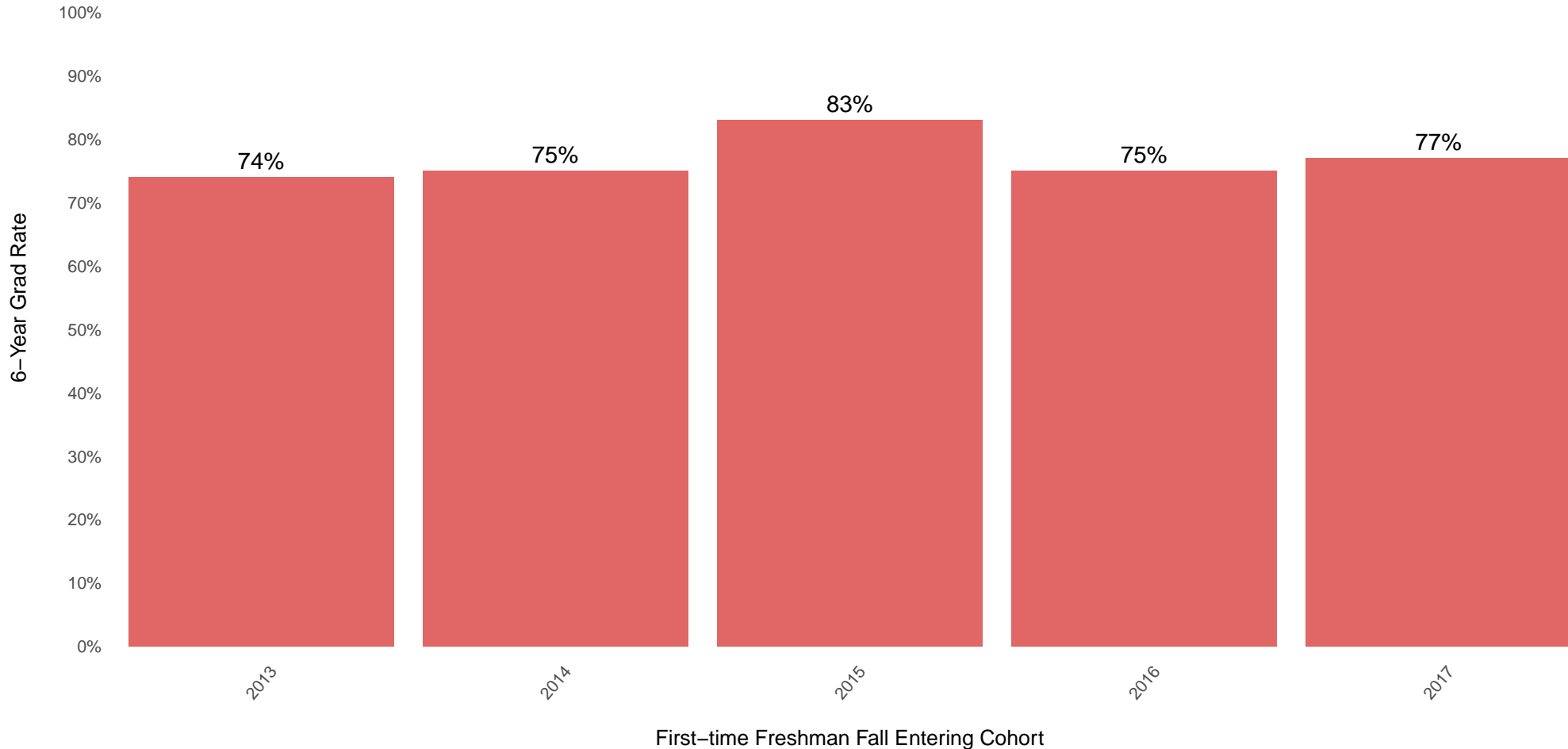

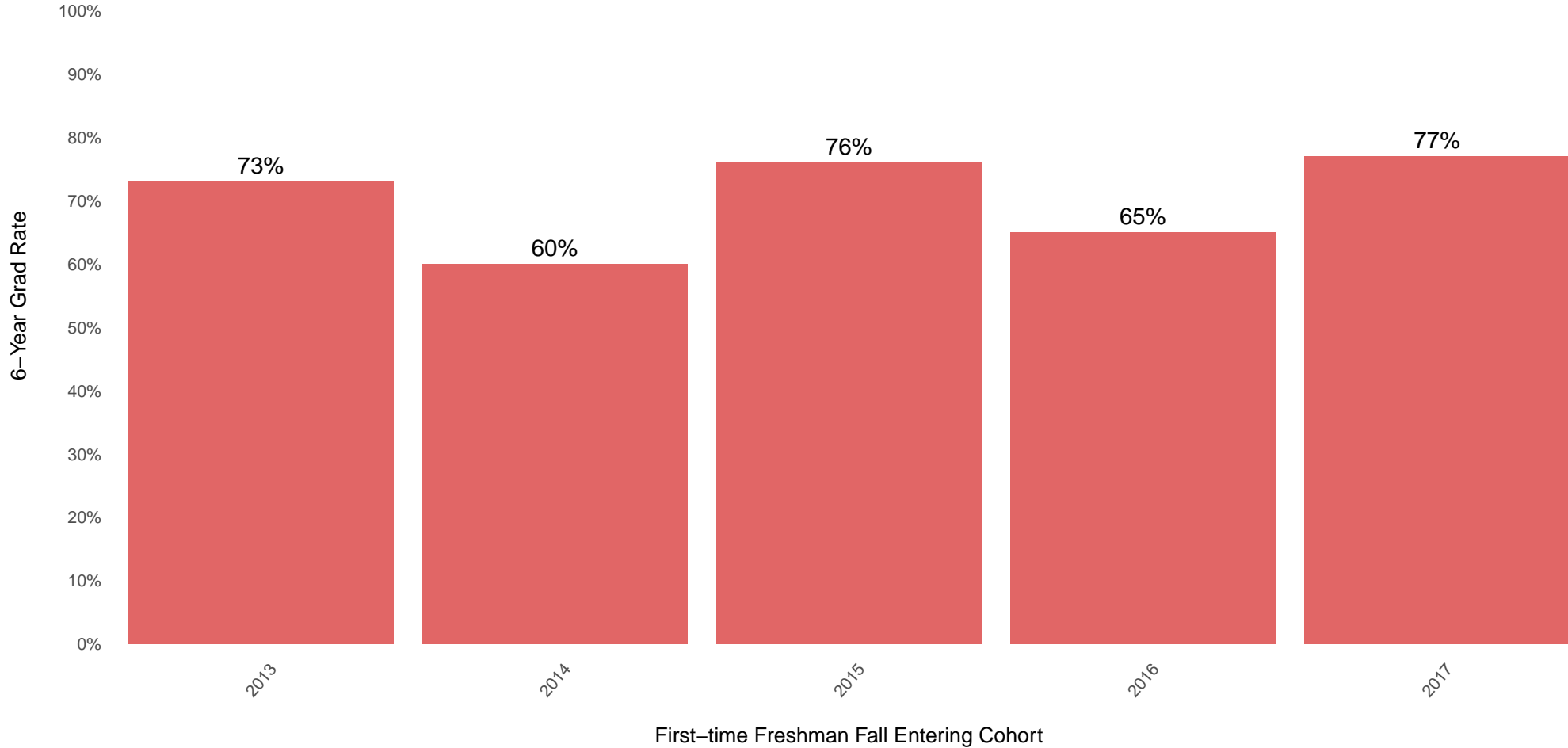

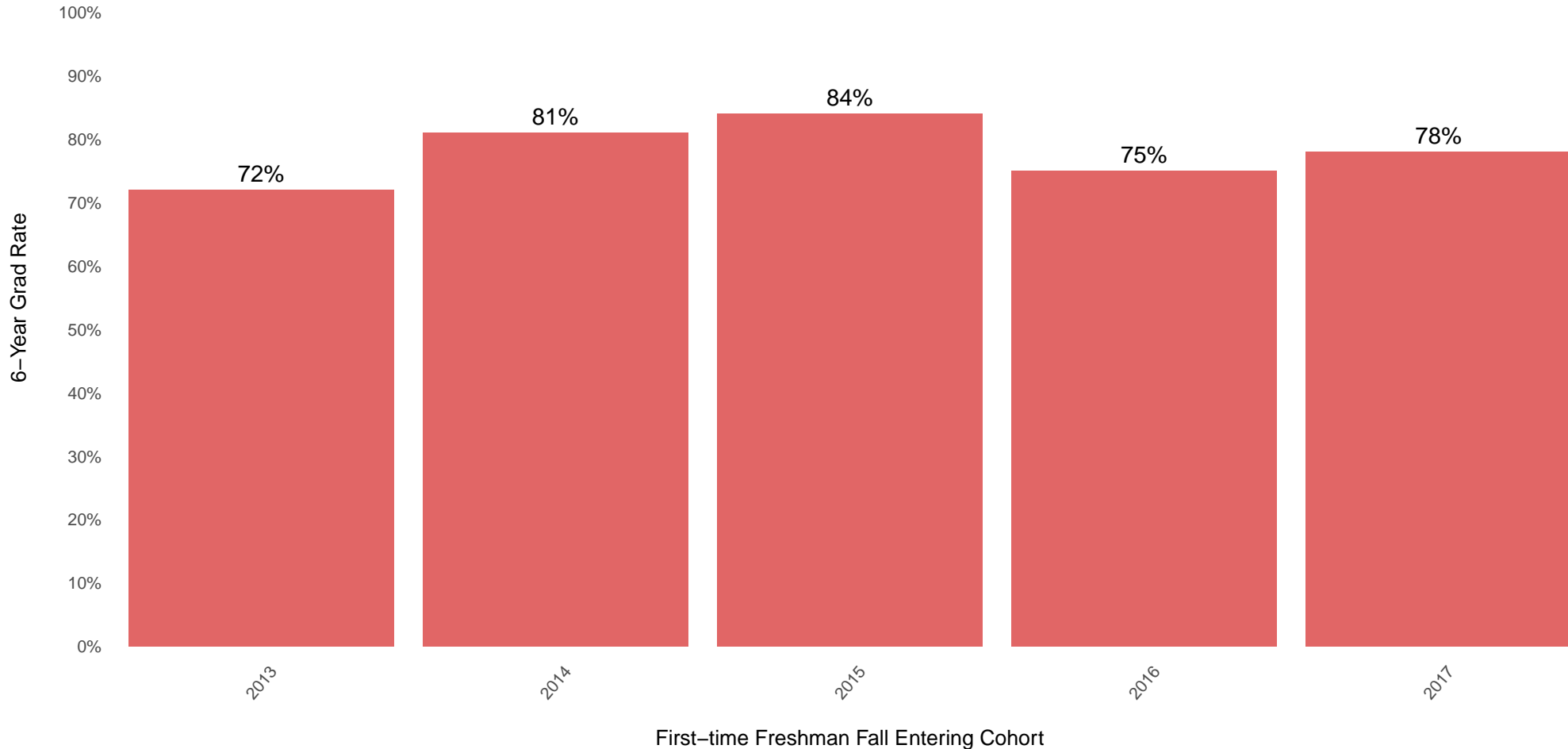

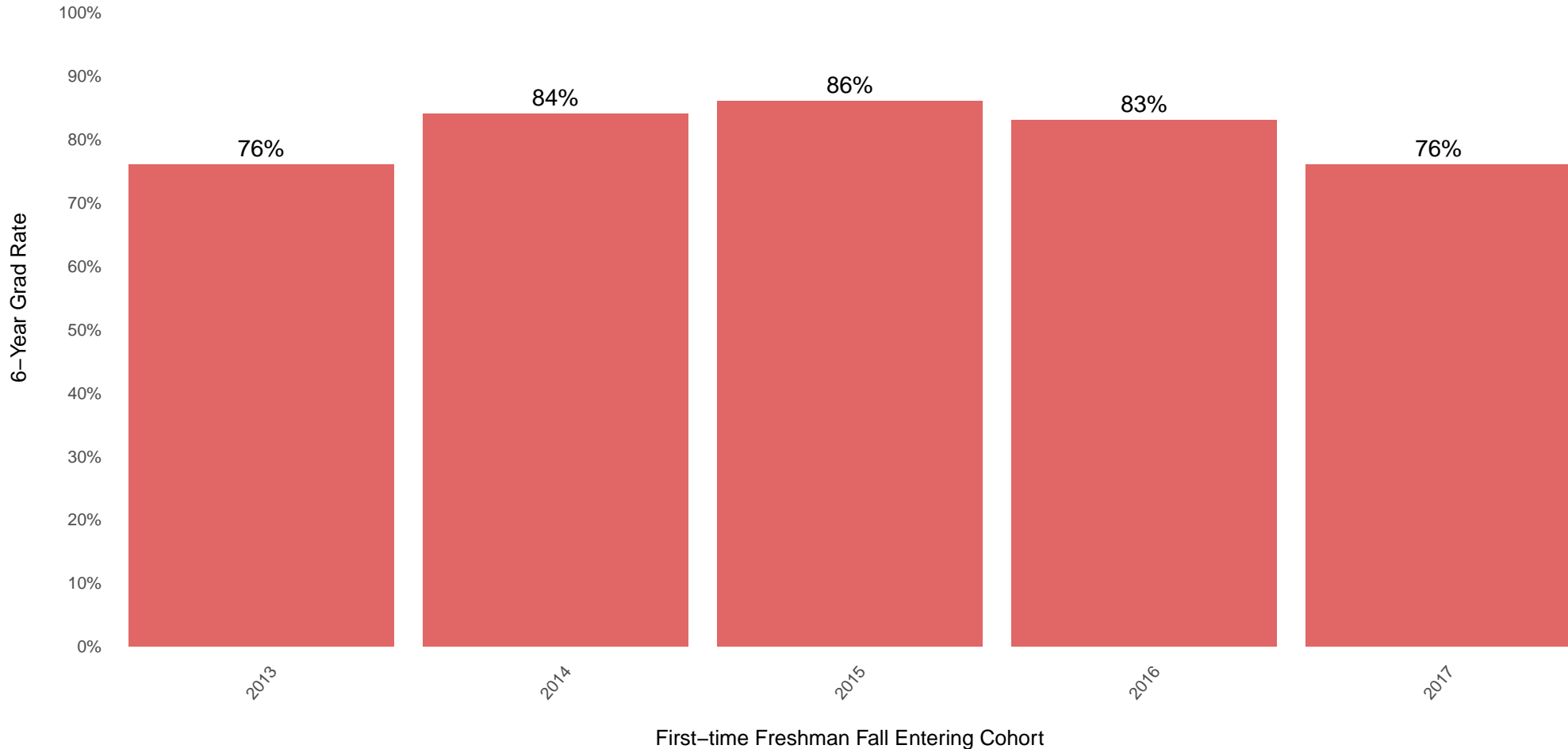

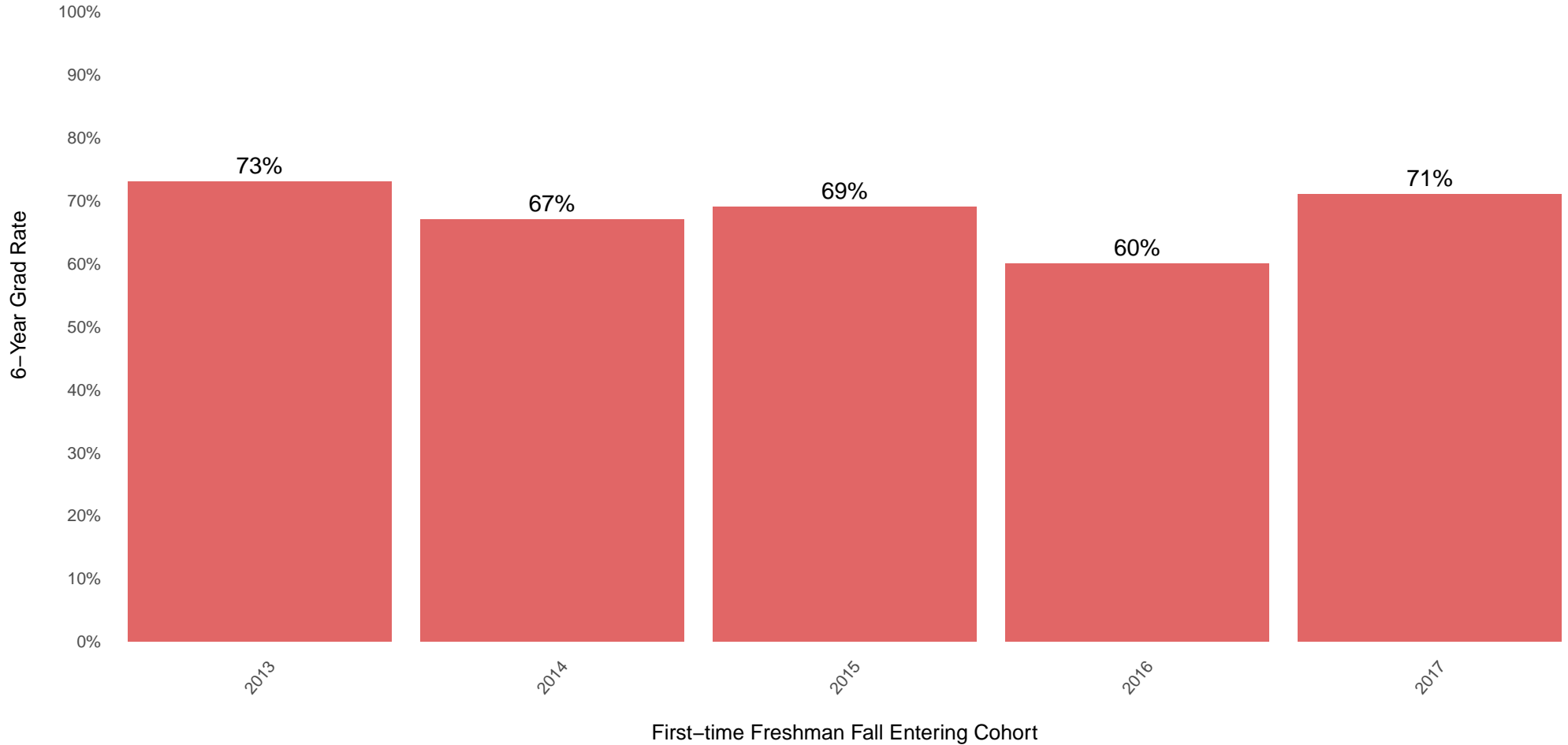

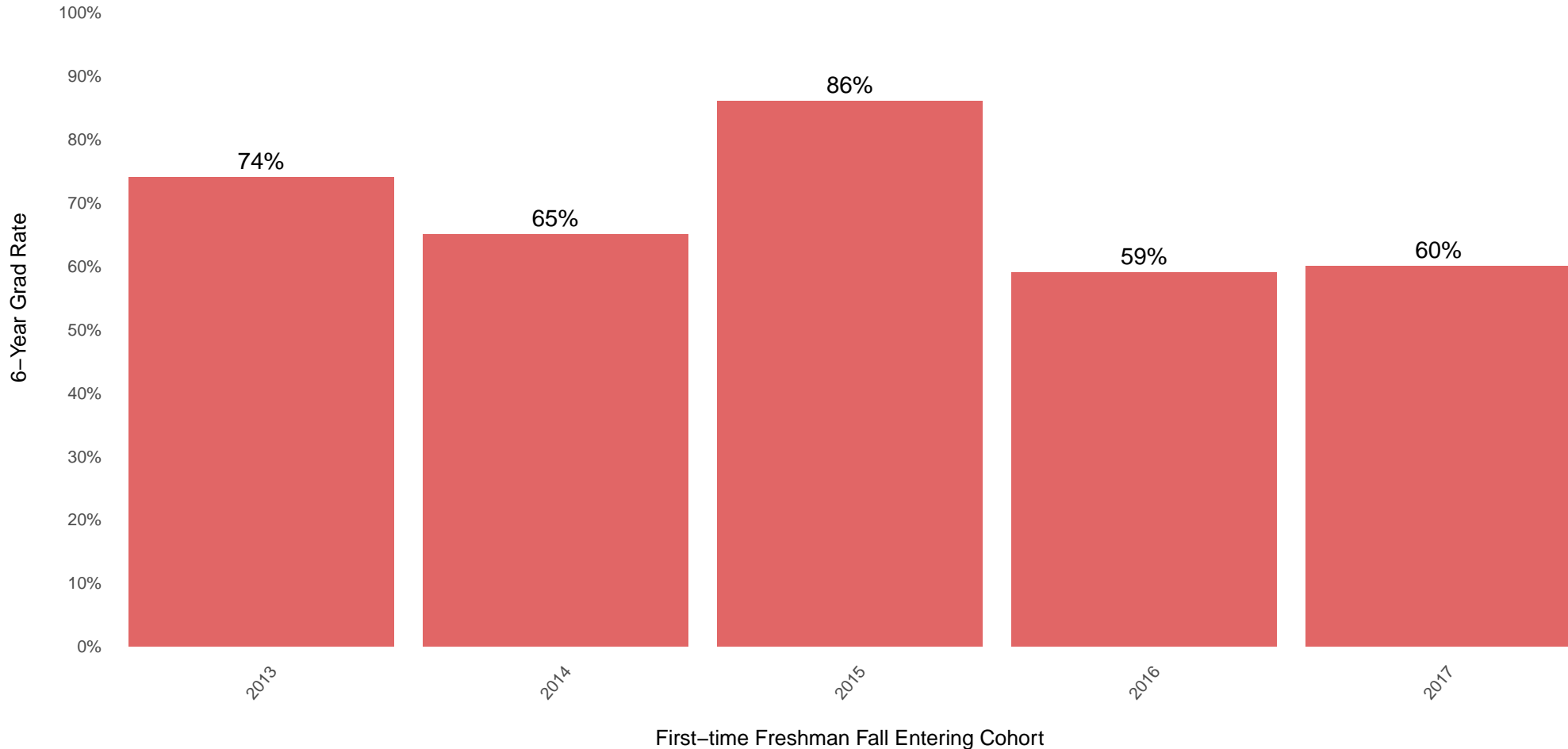

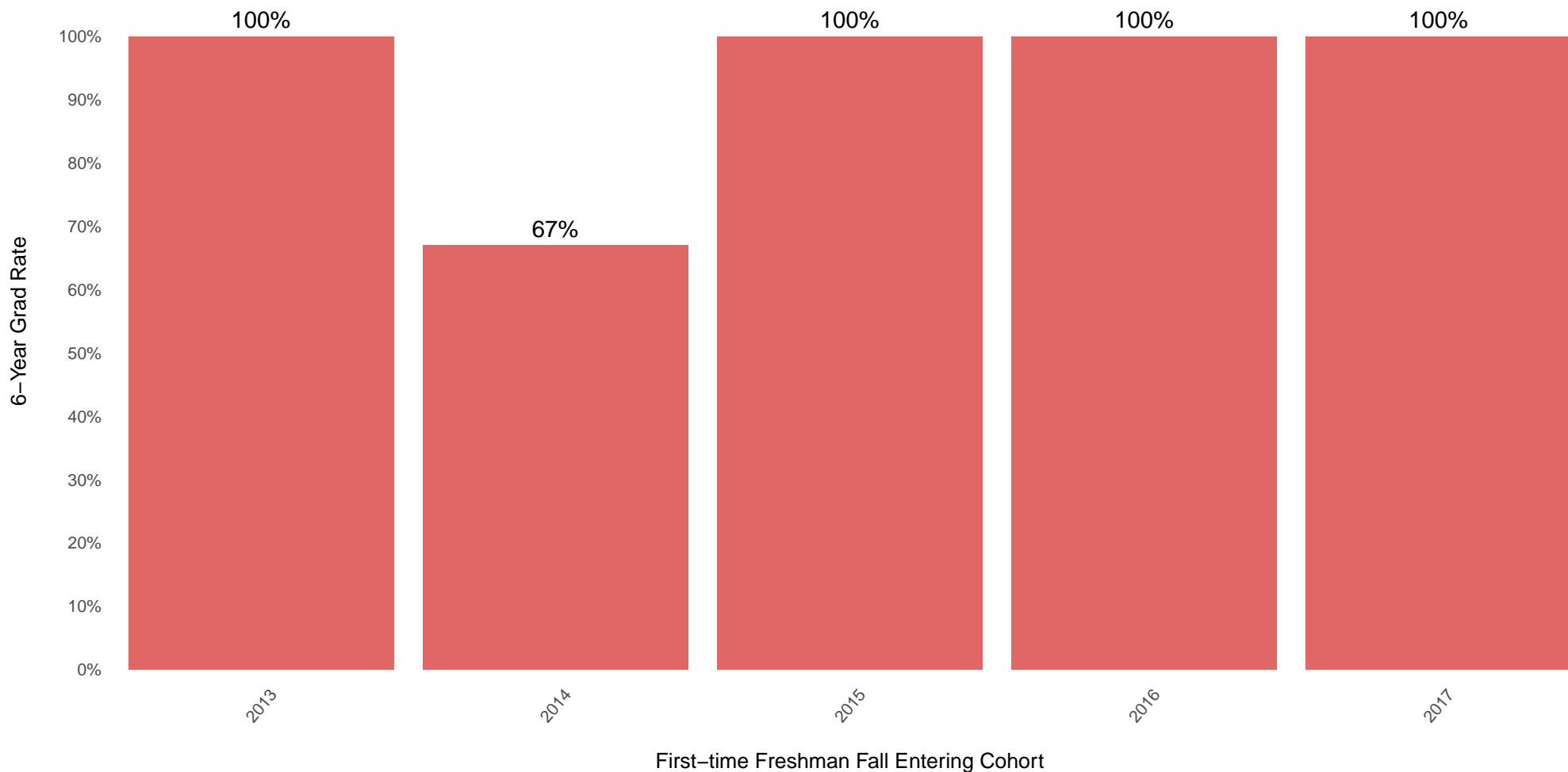

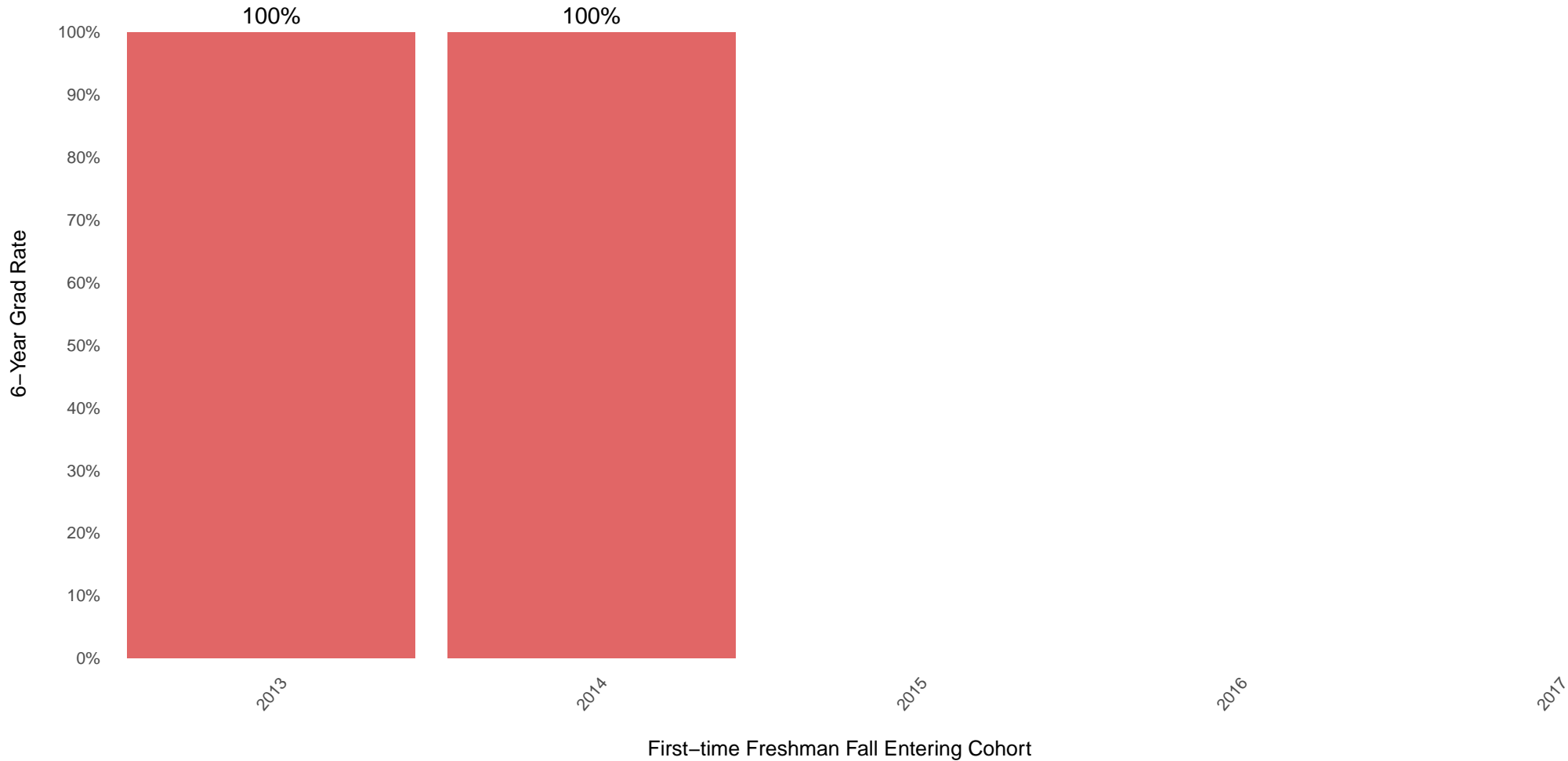

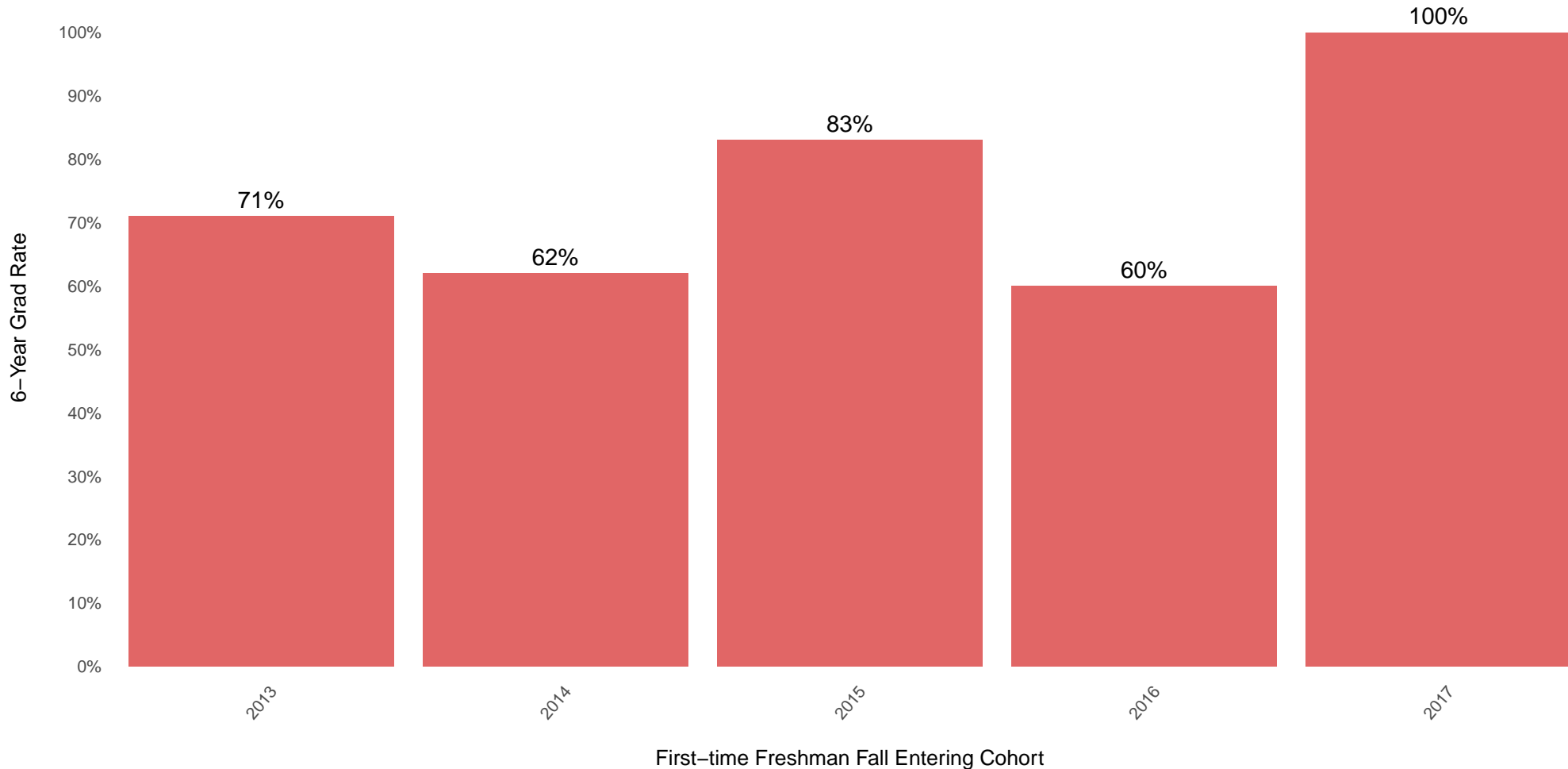

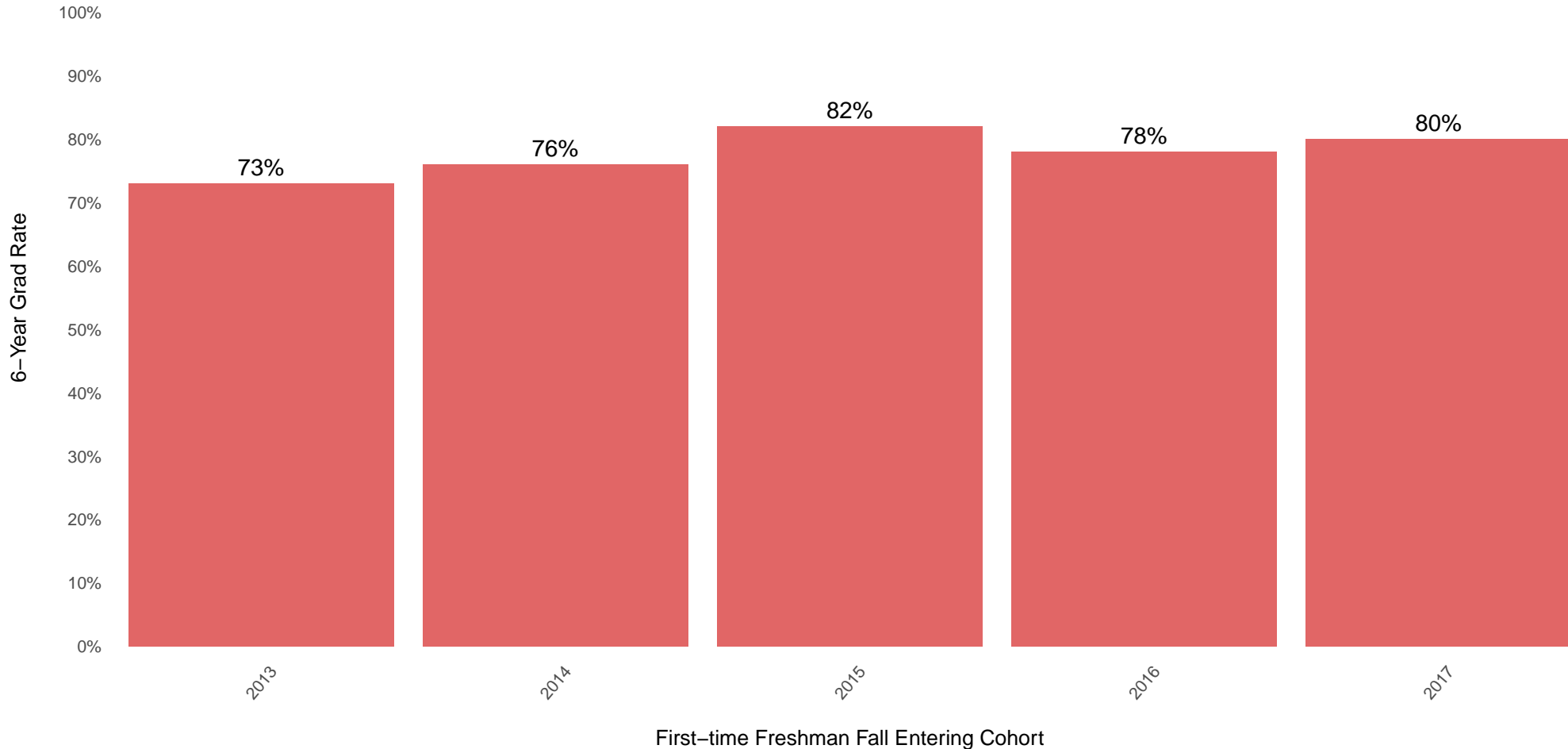

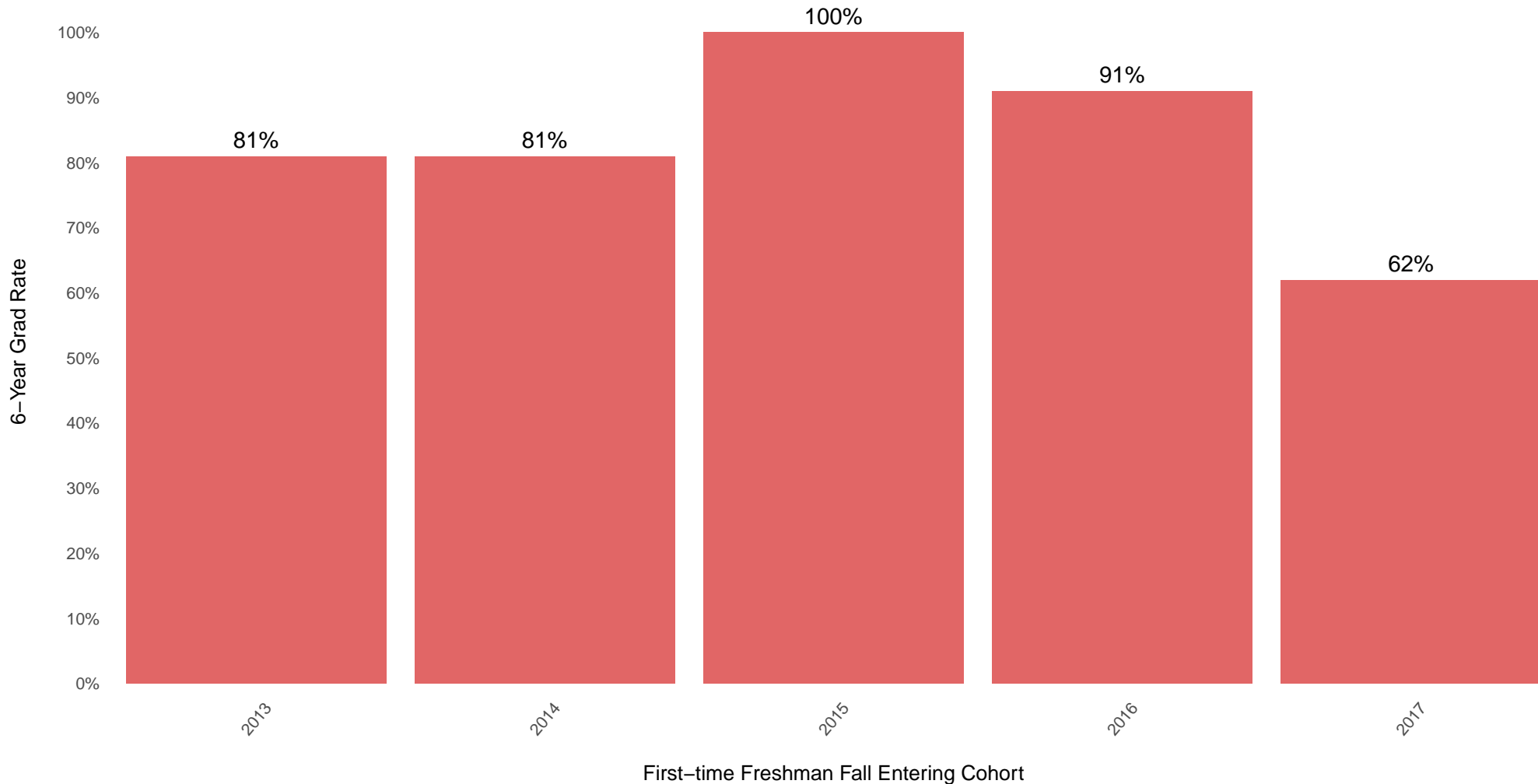

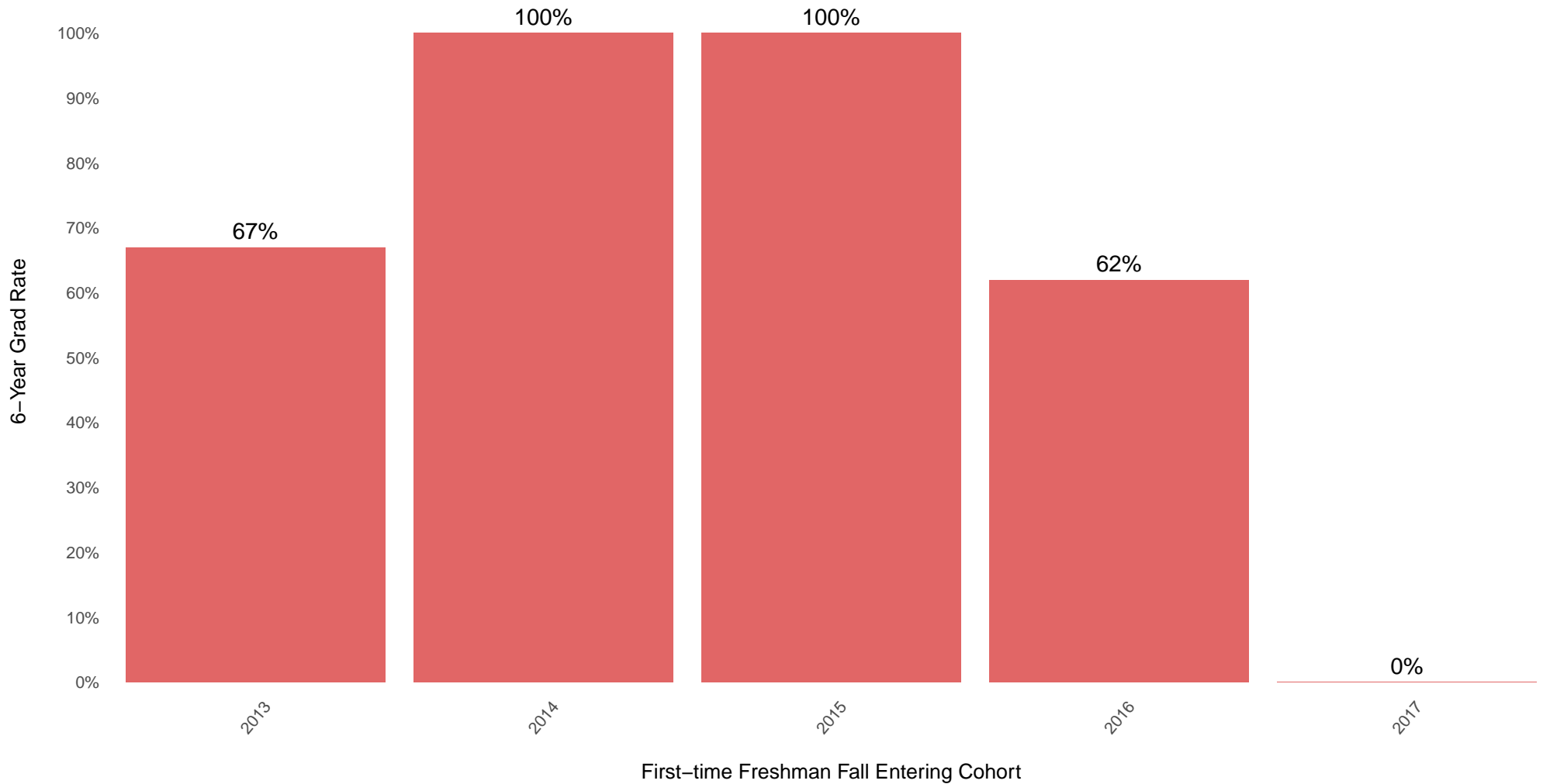
